- 9. Wear proper exercise clothing and shoes for your workout, no loose clothing.



Assembly Instructions

Assembly of the equipment takes professional installers about 2 hours. If this is the first time you have assembled this type of equipment, plan to spend more time. It is strongly recommended to assemble the equipment by professional installers. You may find it quicker, safer, easier to assemble this equipment with the help of a friend, as some of components may be large, heavy or awkward to handle alone. It is important that you assemble your product in a clean, clear, uncluttered area. This will enable you to move around the product while you are fitting components and reduce the possibility of injury during assembly.


№ NOTE

As with any assembled part, proper alignment and adjustment is critical. While tightening the fasteners, be sure to leave room for adjustments. Do not fully tighten the fasteners until instructed to do so. Be careful to assemble the components in the sequence presented in this guide.

STEP 1


- Attach The Connect Frame ASSY (#7) to The Weight Stack Frame ASSY (#1) using: two M12*105 SHCS (#57) two M12 Nylon Lock Nut (#76) four Φ13*Φ24*2.5 Flat Washer (#71)
- 2. Attach one M12*105 SHCS (#57) and one M12 Nylon Lock Nut (#76) and two Φ 13* Φ 24*2.5 Flat Washer (#71) to The Weight Stack Frame ASSY (#1).
- 3. Attach The Side Connecting Frame (#8) to The Weight Stack Frame ASSY (#1) using: two M12*120 SHCS (#57) two Φ 13* Φ 24*2.5 Flat Washers (#71) one Plastic Cover II (#21)
- 4. Attach Main Frame ASSY (#2) to The Connect Frame ASSY (#7) and The Side Connecting Frame (#8) using:

four M12*180 SHCS (#59) four Φ 13* Φ 24*2.5 Flat Washers (#71) two Plastic Cover (#20)



STEP 2

- 1. Attach The Cam Frame ASSY (#5) to The Main Frame ASSY (#2).
- 2. Attach The Wriggled Frame ASSY (#3) to The Main Frame ASSY (#2) using: one Tube $\Phi42*\Phi32*5$ (#47)
- 3. Attach The Seat Frame ASSY (#4) to The Main Frame ASSY (#2) using: one Socket Head Cap Screw M10*25 (#52) one Flat Washer Φ 11* Φ 20*2 (#70) four Flat Washer Φ 13* Φ 24*2.5 (#71) four Nylon Lock Nut M12 (#76) two Screw M8*6 (#61)



STEP 3

1. Attach The Underside Support Plate (#17) to The Weight Stack Frame ASSY (#1) using: two M8*25 BHCS (#64)


two Φ9*Φ16*1.6 Flat Washers (#69)

2. Attach The Front Lower Cover (#31) to The Weight Stack Frame ASSY (#1) and The Underside Support Plate (#17) using:

two M6*20 BHCS (#67)

four Φ6.6*Φ12*1.6 Flat Washers (#68)

one Top Plate ASSY (#30)

to The Weight Stack Frame ASSY (#1) using:

two M8*45 SHCS (#60) two Φ 9* Φ 16*1.6 Flat Washers (#69) two Spring Washer Φ 8 (#73) two Φ 30*65 Rubber Sleeve (#43)

two Tension Spring (#166)

2. Attach The Selector Pin W/Coil (#36) to The Top Plate ASSY (#30).

3. Loosen one M8*8 Screw (#62), and Attach:

one Φ14*1296 Guide Rod (#16) one 5LBS Counter Weight (#19)




Weight plate sticker paste schematic diagram



Weight plate sticker paste schematic diagram



General Maintenance Information

Links, Pull-Pins, Snap Hooks, Swivels, Weight Stack Pins:

- * Check all pieces for signs of visible wear or damage.
- * Check springs in snap hooks and pull-pins for proper tension and alignment.
- * If the spring sticks or has lost its rigidity, replace it immediately.

Upholstery:

- * To ensure prolonged upholstery life and proper hygiene, all upholstered pads should be wiped down with a damp cloth after every workout.
- * Periodically take the time to use a mild soap or an approved vinyl upholstery cleaner to deter the onset of cracking or drying. Avoid using any abrasive cleaners or cleaners not intended for use on vinyl.
- * Replace ripped or warn upholstery immediately.
- * Keep sharp or pointed objects clear of all upholstery.

Decals:

* Inspect and familiarize yourself with any safety warnings or other user information posted on each decal.

Nuts and Bolts:

- * Inspect all nuts and bolts for any loosening and tighten if needed.
- * Go through a re-tightening sequence periodically to ensure that all hardware is tensioned proper.

Anti-Skid Surfaces:

* These surfaces are designed to supply secure footing and need to be replaced if they appear worn or become slippery.

Belts and Cables:

- * We uses only high quality belt, and mil-spec cables.
- * Visually inspect the belts and cables for fraying, cracking, peeling or discoloration.
- * While the machine is not in use, carefully run your fingers along the belt or cable to feel for thinning or bulging areas.
- * Replace belts and cables immediately at the first signs of damage or wear. Do not use equipment until belts or cables have been replaced.

Belt and Cable Tension:

- * Referring to the Owners Manual, when belts or cables are used check all bolts attachments to be sure they are properly attached.
- * Check slack in cables and re-adjust cable tension if needed.

Seat Sleeves, Guide Rods:

- * Wipe down adjusting tubes with a dust free rag before applying lubricant.
- * Lubricate seat sleeves and Guide Rods with a Silicon or Teflon based lubricant spray.

Linear Bearings:

* Referring to the Owners Manual carefully disassemble the bearing from its housing and place a finger full of light grease (lithium, super lube, etc.) into the inside of the bearing. Using your finger, press the grease into the ball-bearings and their tracks. repeat until the ball-bearing tracks are full of grease. Insert the shaft back into the bearing and wipe off excess grease.

To be successful in your exercise program, it is important to develop an understanding of the basic principles of strength training. Now that you have your equipment, it is only natural that you want to get started immediately. First, determine a set of realistic goals and objectives for yourself. By deciding on an exercise plan that is right for you prior to starting, you will contribute significantly to your success.

Warm up properly before engaging in weight resistance training. Stretching, yoga, jogging, calisthenics or other cardiovascular exercise can help prepare your body for the heavier workload of lifting weights.

Learn how to perform the exercise correctly before using heavy weight. Correct form is important to avoid injury and to ensure that you work the proper muscle groups.

Know your limitations. If you are new to weight training or are embarking on an exercise regimen after a long layoff, start slowly and build foundational strength over a longer period of time.

Pay attention to your breathing. Exhale when you exert is a general rule of thumb. Never hold your breath.
